B). DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PART-TIME ACADEMIC POSITIONS

- i). Teaching undergraduate students and or postgraduate students;

- iii). Delivering the course content to students through lectures, ensuring that they follow the curriculum objectives;
- iv). Evaluating the delivery models and making appropriate improvements to ensure quality teaching and learning;
- v). Setting, moderating, invigilating and marking examinations;
- vi). Carrying out a needs assessment for curriculum, identify the content gaps in order to produce competent graduates;
- vii). Participation in the University activities: open day, field day, exhibition for the enhancement of the image of the University.

D). REQUIREMENTS: PART-TIME LECTURER

- i). Applicants should hold a PhD or a master's degree in a relevant area and possess vast teaching or industry experience at undergraduate/ postgraduate levels.
- ii). Applicants must have served as a Lecturer or equivalent industry experience in a university or institution recognized by the Senate of JOOUST.
- iii). At least two (2) years teaching experience in a university.
