MULTI VENOUS TRAINING ARM SPECIFICATIONS

Standard requirements;

Training arm with features of a conventional intravenous arm, as well as intramuscular and subcutaneous injections practice.

Features

Should have Subcutaneous injection areas on the volar side of the forearm and the lateral side of the upper arm.

Should be capable of the performing the following simulations:

Simulated cephalic, basilic, antecubital, radial, and ulnar veins, clenched fist and tourniquet position, collapsed veins, infusion technique

Administration of medication by intravenous bolus, Blood collection exercises with simulated blood, Intramuscular injection site in deltoid area, Prominent venous network, Resealing veins and outer skin and a Realistic “pop” as needle enters vein.

Should be supplied with additional Replacement skin for multipurpose venous training arm.
