**REPORTING DATE FOR NEW FIRST YEAR STUDENTS (KCSE COHORT 2019),
2020/2021 ACADEMIC YEAR AND EXAMINATIONS FOR CONTINUING
STUDENTS**

The University suspended studies in March, 2020 due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. During the period, the University has been able to conduct online exams for postgraduate, 4th years, final Diploma and Certificate students. Following the Ministry of Education notice on 29th September, 2020, providing direction on progressive re-opening of institutions from 5th October 2020, the University Senate held a special Senate on 2nd October 2020 and agreed as follows:

**A. REPORTING DATE FOR 1st YEARS(KCSE 2019 COHORT) AND
COMMENCEMENT OF STUDIES**

The University takes this opportunity to congratulate all the freshers following their KUCCPS placement to Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science and Technology.

❖ The New first years 2019 (KCSE) shall be expected to report to the Main Campus in Bondo on **21st October 2020**.

❖ **Semester Fees:** All semester fees **MUST** be paid before students are registered.

Mode of Payment: All fees should be paid to Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science and Technology in the following bank accounts:

- i. Equity Bank Account No. **0750294239156**, **Bondo Branch** or
- ii. Co-operative Bank, Account No. **01129255709500**, **Siaya Branch** or any other branches of the two banks countrywide.

- ❖ **Registration:** This exercise began online but will continue online up to Friday, 16th October, 2020.

The following forms/ documents duly completed shall be deposited in the office of the Registrar (Academic Affairs). The forms include:

- i. A copy of the admission letter fully signed.
- ii. A copy of KCSE certificate or Result Slip.
- iii. A copy of the National Identity Card (ID) or valid passport and Birth Certificate.
- iv. Duly filled forms:
 - a) Letter of Acceptance (JOOUST/AA/R/ADM-AF/01).
 - b) Student's Personal details (JOOUST/AA/R/ADM-AF/02).
 - c) Students Entrance Medical Examination (JOOUST/AA/R/ADM-AF/03).
 - d) Emergency Operations(s) (JOOUST/AA/R/ADM-AF/04).
 - e) Declaration (JOOUST/AA/R/ADM-AF/05).

Note: Those who had sent the said documents online or through post office should confirm receipt of the same with Admissions office and they therefore need not submit other copies.

- v. The following original documents shall be required for mandatory verification.
 - a) Original letter of offer
 - b) Original KCSE certificate or Result Slip
 - c) National Identity Card /Birth Certificate

B. EXAMINATIONS FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS 2019/2020 ACADEMIC YEAR

End of Semester two exams for continuing students shall be conducted as follows:

Note:

- i). Online Registration for exams begins on 12/10/2020 and ends on 16/10/2020 (Log on to the website on registration for exam and fill your details).The page will automatically close at 5pm on Friday, 16/10/2020 and there will be no extension.
- ii). All fees must be cleared before sitting for examinations.
- iii). Students who had incomplete practicals can arrange with respective schools and come to campus one week earlier.
- iv). Continuing students shall start studies for the 2020/2021 Academic year online as soon as they are through with the exams while at home.
- v) Institution- based part timers shall learn online from 19th November 2020
- vi) This schedule applies across campuses and programmes.

C. COVID-19 CONTAINMENT MEASURES

All students to buy for themselves enough and proper face masks/shields, which will be mandatory to wear in public places and classes. Hand sanitizers, washing soap and water are available on campus. Every students must arrange for their own medical cover for inpatient hospitalization should need arise as per the University policy. Outpatient cover shall however be provided by the University. To facilitate online learning students are expected to buy their own laptops, smart phones or iPads. The limited accommodation space on campus shall be allocated strictly to first years only on a 'first-come first served' basis. Continuing students and first years who will not have secured University hostels to look for alternative accommodation outside the University.

Note: JOOUST is a corruption free zone; beware of fraudsters and conmen. Do not make payment whatsoever to anybody other than JOOUST specified accounts
